



LOCATOR Life: From Overdenture to LOCATOR FIXED- Full Arch Restorative Education

Participants will attend a combination online & in-person course on full-arch implantology leading to a greater awareness of case planning and step-by-step protocols on how to work with dental implants. The online course covers evidence and clinical based lecture theory with fundamentals of full-arch cases, step-by-step protocols for overdenture treatment, and fundamentals of patient management and maintenance.
