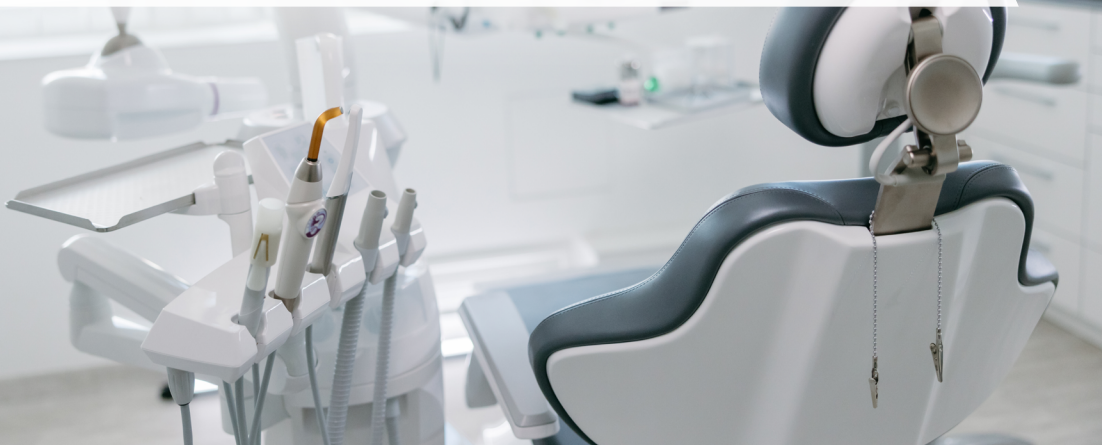


INTEGRATED DIGITAL WORKFLOWS FOR FULL-ARCH IMPLANT DENTISTRY



COURSE SUMMARY

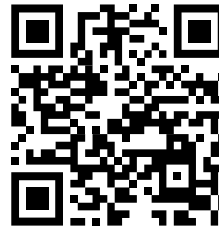

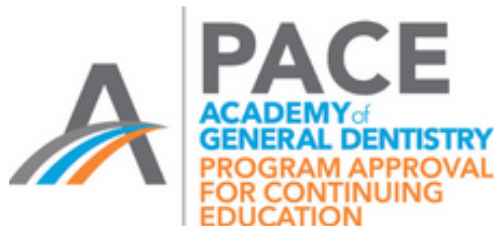
Dr. Michael Klein D.D.S.
